All the expenditure shall be met from National Ayush Mission and Departmental Budget and no additional funds bearing either one time or recurring implications shall be provided for this purpose from State Budget.

Acharya Charaka Policy

Guidelines for Provision of Free Diagnostics and Drugs in AYUSH Health Institutions, Himachal Pradesh.

Objective

The Acharya Charaka Policy aims to enhance healthcare accessibility by providing free diagnostics and essential drugs to patients in AYUSH hospitals and Dispensaries across Himachal Pradesh, free of cost. This initiative shall support equitable healthcare by promoting Indian Systems of Medicine, ensuring high-quality care for all citizens of the State.

Scope

This policy shall be applicable to all AYUSH hospitals and Dispensaries (Ayurveda, Yoga, Unani, Siddha and Homeopathy) managed by the Government of Himachal Pradesh. The services under this policy shall be available to all patients visiting these facilities.

Key Provisions

Free Diagnostics:

- a) A wide range of diagnostic tests, including basic blood tests, urine tests and other essential diagnostics as per **Annexure-X** will be provided free of cost in all AYUSH Hospitals
- b) The diagnostic services shall meet quality standards, and regular monitoring will be done to ensure timely and accurate testing. The responsibility in this regard is hereby entrusted to the Incharge/Medical Superintendent of the concerned Hospital.
- c) The patients who have been prescribed any test out of the list as per this policy by any AHC/AHWC shall also be entertained free of cost in any AYUSH Hospital across the State.

Free Drugs:

- a) AYUSH hospitals will provide free essential drugs based on the prescribed treatment, covering Ayurveda, Unani, Siddha, and Homeopathy formulations.
- b) A comprehensive list of essential AYUSH drugs will be maintained and regularly updated by the Department of AYUSH, Himachal Pradesh.
- c) Every AYUSH Health institution shall have a minimum stock of ASU&H Drugs as per requirement and Allopathic Drugs required for emergency management alongwith adequate stock of consumables like dressing material, diagnostic strips etc.
- d) AYUSH Department shall finalize the facility wise Essential Drugs List (EDL) as per requirement in AYUSH Health Institutions. This shall be reviewed after every two years by a Committee comprising of following:

e) This EDL Committee shall deliberate on the Drugs and the consumables which shall be required for management of common diseases like fever, common cold, cough, bronchitis, diarrhea, dysentery, acidity, abdominal pain, joint pains, anemia, diabetes, hypertension etc. and are required for management of the patients in various AYUSH Hospitals and AHCs of the State in the public health sector on a day to day basis. Emergency drugs and life-saving medicines, if required, will also be made available as per patient needs.

f) The essential drug list is being notified along with this policy for the first time as **Annexure-Y** as per the recommendations of the Committee constituted above and subsequently the Committee shall meet in the month of December of every odd year and finalize its recommendations after deliberation. After the notification of this policy along with EDL, the Committee shall meet in December, 2025 and every two years thereafter.

g) All drugs will be sourced from approved vendors to ensure authenticity, quality, and efficacy as per the procurement policy of the State.

Eligibility

All patients visiting government AYUSH hospitals in Himachal Pradesh are eligible for free diagnostics and drugs under the Acharya Charaka Policy, regardless of socio-economic background.

Monitoring and Evaluation:

- a) A dedicated monitoring committee will be established to oversee the implementation of the policy across all AYUSH hospitals under the chairmanship of Medical Superintendent/ Incharge of the concerned hospital.
- b) Hospitals will submit monthly reports to the Directorate detailing the number of patients, diagnostics conducted, and drugs dispensed.
- c) Random audits and inspections will be conducted to ensure the proper implementation of this policy.

Awareness and Outreach

A campaign will be launched to inform the general public about the availability of free diagnostic public awareness and drug services under the Acharya Charaka Policy.

Information will be disseminated through various channels including social media, posters, and local community engagement programs.

Grievance Redressal

Each hospital will have a designated officer responsible for addressing patient complaints and ensuring timely resolution. Besides this institutional grievance redressal mechanism, any aggrieved patients can report the matter on Mukhya Mantri Seva Sankalp Help line.

Funding

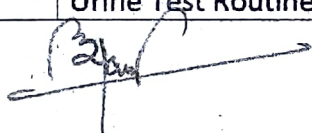
The funds for the implementation of this policy shall be sourced from the appropriate heads under National AYUSH Mission and the State Budget.

Review and Amendments

The Acharya Charaka Policy will be reviewed annually to assess its effectiveness and make necessary amendments in response to evolving healthcare needs and advancements in AYUSH practices.

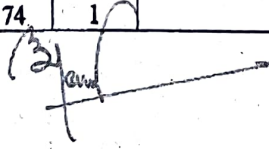
